In receipt of your letter of the 8<sup>th</sup> May a.c. and of  
the memorandum attached respecting the screw  
shaft of the "Sc. Dr. Elwine Koppen" I must tell  
you the truth that I did not measure the pitch  
and the diameter of the propeller myself but  
this was done by the engineer of the erecting shop.  
Now I have taken the measurement of the spare  
screw, ordered of the dimensions of the screw fitted,  
which is favourably reported upon by the master,  
and found the diameter of the screw = 12 feet 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"  
and the pitch 14' 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

I beg kindly to excuse the mistake made by me  
and to amend the respective ciphers of the First  
Entry Report, same to be fit to be submitted for the  
consideration of the Committee.
