An examination was made of the Nos. 1 and 2 main engine cylinder covers and it was recommended that a further examination should be made by the end of March, 1959. The Committee have continued the class subject to this matter receiving attention by the time stated.

The inboard generator governor was also examined and found satisfactory, and the Committee have deleted this condition of class.


The Donkey Boiler Survey was completed and the notation DBS 1,58 has now been assigned.
