Motorship "CASSIAN SEA"

(S) With reference to my letter of the 27th November last, I have to inform you that the report of the General Examination on the hull and machinery carried out at Rotterdam in December/January last has received consideration in this office. In view of the satisfactory results of this survey the Committee have confirmed their agreement to postpone the Special Survey until the end of December, 1958.

With regard to the machinery, the class has been continued subject to the Main Engine cylinder covers, Nos. 1 and 2, being specially examined and the inboard generator governor being repaired and examined under working conditions before the end of July, 1958.

To complete the Donkey Boiler Survey, which became due in December, 1957, the safety valves of both donkey Boilers and the exhaust gas boiler remain to be adjusted, and the steam smothering fuel oil units and remote controls require to be examined under working conditions.

With regard to the adjustment of the safety valves of the exhaust gas boiler, I shall be glad if you will arrange for the Chief Engineer to attend to this at sea and forward to this office a certified statement to the effect that this has been carried out.

A record of Docking Survey 2,58 has been assigned.
