Motorship "CASSIAN SEA"

I confirm the telephone conversation with Mr. Orfanides yesterday, when he stated that it is proposed to sell this ship for scrap and to send her from Argostoli to Rijeka for that purpose.

To enable the Society's Surveyors to issue a certificate for the ship to proceed under her own power to Rijeka, it will be necessary for the vessel to be examined and found or placed in satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage as an unclassified ship.

Concerning the machinery, as steam is necessary for essential services, at least two boilers should be surveyed, the main and auxiliary machinery tried under working conditions, including the pumping arrangements and electrical equipment.

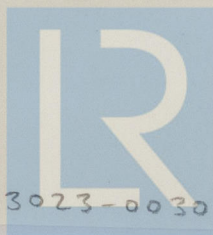
A short sea trial should also be held to ensure that navigability and entry of sea circulating water are not seriously impaired.
