The Notation "Class Suspended 1,59 - Surveys Overdue" appears in the Register Book.

Prior to the class being suspended the class was subject to port and starboard longitudinal bulkheads of Nos. 7 & 9 centre tank (in way of doubling plates) being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary next drydocking.

The PIRAEUS Surveyors report (9,59), ship examined afloat and the requirements of a General Examination carried out to enable her to be towed as an hulk to Alexandria (refer letter dated 13.8.59).
