TEAR & TEAR REPAIRS

Rudder axle coupling bolts hardened up on account of slackness in same.

Grooving on sides of sternframe sole piece at edge of keel plates, cleaned and built up with electric welding.

P. & S. bower anchor crown shackle pins renewed.

Nos. 2 & 3 starboard wing cargo tank hatch covers doubled.

R. LIST.

Rudder main piece below coupling(E.W. 12/58) specially examined at this time and found to continue efficient. It is submitted that this item be now deleted from the S.R. List.

Shell plates "G"4 & 5, "H"4, 5 & 6(p.s.f.) and "H"3 & 4(s.s.f.) examined and found to continue efficient.




