EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR DOCKING

W. & T. Repairs:

A few scrubbed rivets on p.s "F" strake plating lower landing amidships now ring welded and shell plating subsequently hose tested and proved tight and sound.

MACHINERY:

Examined propeller after end of stern bush and outside fastenings and all found in good order W.D. 0.10"

CONDITION OF CLASS: S.R.L.No.181 Stern frame (E.W.2,60) to be specially examined drydocking.

NOW DONE:

Stern frame specially examined and welded repair found satisfactory. It is submitted that present Condition of Class be retained meanwhile and that same be specially examined next drydocking.
