2 Coal hatches on freeboard deck (P. & S.) abreast boiler casing now permanently  
plated over.

Following removal of deep tanks between Nos. 1 & 2 holds (P. & S.) openings for  
air and sounding pipes for these tanks efficiently plated over.

Air pipes from aft end No. 1 D.B. tank and forw'd end of No. 2 D.B. tank now moved  
aft and forw'd (against bulkhead) respectively; P and S sides.

Opening in freeboard deck for extension spindle of suction valve from original  
deep tanks also efficiently and permanently plated over.
