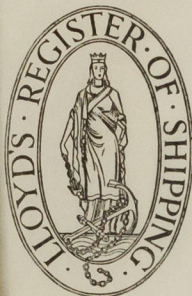

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners, attend on board the

S/T "DRIADE"

8890 tons gross of Panama, whilst lying afloat at Molo Galliera, Genoa on the 29th July, 1959 and subsequently for the purpose of carrying out an examination with a view to ascertaining whether the ship was in an efficient condition to be towed from Genoa to La Spezia.

The ship was found to have all hatches closed and battened down, ventilators and air pipes, companionways, doors, skylights, and side scuttles closed.

The rudder was securely locked in the amidships position, and the main engines shut down.

The summer cargo tanks were all completely empty.

Nos. 1, 7 & 9 main cargo tanks were empty, the remainder full of water ballast.

The double bottom tanks were all empty.

The oil fuel bunkers and settling tanks were empty.

The Fore & After Peak tanks were empty, as were also the fore'd deep tanks.

The boilers were empty.

"Not under command" signals were in place.

The anchors were being used for mooring purposes, but would be raised into their hawse pipes before departure.— The windlass is electrically operated allowing the anchors to be raised or lowered as may be necessary.

The ship's derricks and all moveable fittings secured in place.

The ship was found in fit condition to be towed from Genoa to La Spezia in favourable weather conditions, provided adequate towing arrangements are made which arrangements are not the responsibility of this Society.
