I am in receipt of your letter of the 13th instant with reference to Hamburg First Entry Report No.19522 on the Twin Screw Oil Tanker "KAJA KNUTSEN". (Blohm & Voss' Yard No.488), and have to ~~thank~~ that your remarks have been carefully noted.

In reply, I have to ~~state~~ that when the tonnage of the vessel has been ascertained it is considered that an account for the full amount of the fee for the Special Survey of the hull should be rendered to Messrs.Blohm & Voss, leaving that firm to make their own arrangements with Messrs.Gotaverken as to the amount, if any, payable by the latter.

When the total fee has been received, 95% of it will be credited to your Office and 5% to the Gothenburg Office.
