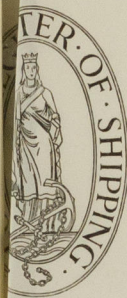



being fit to carry Petroleum in Bulk.



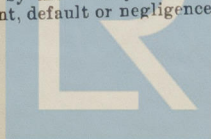
