I beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee two test certificates for chain cables supplied to two Steam Trawlers building by Messrs Cochrane & Sons, and which are designated Nos, 421 and 422, respectfully in the Builders works. In the case of 421, the weight of the cables appears to be 14r-11lbs light before being galvanized.

whilst the cable for No. 422 appears to be 14r-9lbs light.

I shall be pleased to be informed if those cables may be accepted and also if the weight added by galvanizing can be recognized in making up the Rule weight.

The approved plans of Midship Section are also enclosed for reference.
