Motorship "GADILA"

A report has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Singapore from which it is noted that seven lengths of chain cable and a bower anchor have been lost.

Seven lengths of chain cable and the spare bower anchor were fitted at this time, however, and the Surveyors have recommended that a bower anchor should be supplied at the earliest opportunity. The Committee have continued the class of this ship subject to this being done, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are being made for a bower anchor to be supplied.
