Structure of Present Survey: (Afloat and in dry dock)

Equipment - reported loss of 7 lengths of c.c. and one bower anchor stated to have been caused by 7th length fracturing when raising anchor. 7 lengths of c.c. renewed and spare bower anchor fitted in hawsepipe. The Singapore Surveyors report that the fractured chain cable link was gauged and found to ~~be~~ ^{be} 2.5/16" diameter. (Note - Rule diameter 2.7/16" and renewal size 2.3/16" dia.)

Recommendation:

SUBMITTED this ship is eligible to remain as classed, SUBJECT to a bower anchor being supplied at the earliest opportunity.
