Application for Certificate of Approval of the Position of the Centre of the Disc, and of the Lines to be used in connexion therewith, under the provisions of the International Load Line Convention, 1930.

Application is hereby made to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping for a certificate of approval of the position [or alteration of the position] of the centre of the disc and of the lines to be used in connexion therewith (steam ship) (sailing ship) DOWNSHIRE Official No. 148142.
