Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter which has today been addressed to Mr. Eide at Bergen having reference to some discussions he has had with Messrs. H.M. Wrangell & Co., regarding the classification of a ship building for them in Helsingborg.

We understood from Mr. Siggers at Gothenburg that transfer was likely to be made to N.V. class on the plea that they were dissatisfied with the stiffening required to the transverse tanker "GARD" which has recently been under consideration at Copenhagen.

My object in writing to you is to ask whether you could ascertain and report to me what are the N.V. requirements for the stiffening of such ships.

Please let me have your comments as soon as possible.
