It is submitted the Copenhagen Surveyors  
informed by cable in reply to their letter  
of the 11th ult., as follows: -

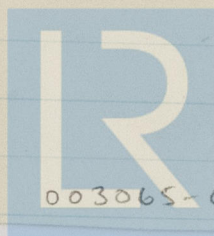
Messrs Burmeister & Wain 315 steamer if completely  
awning deck provisional summer  
at least ten feet two inches from statutory  
line and three quarters inches above 3"  
on steel  
awning Deck side.

Confirming cable the Surveyors should be  
informed that the freeboard intimated is  
based upon the cargo and bunkers  
and coamings on the awning Deck being  
24 inches high and <sup>with</sup> the hatch webs  
in accordance with Table A. Sec: 32 of the Rules,  
and no scuppers or other openings in the  
deck affect the position of the load line disc,  
the vessel being built in accordance with  
the Rules already approved, except as regards  
modification to a completely closed awning deck  
instead of shelter-deck type.  
The vessel would then be 100A.1. Awning Deck  
freeboard.
