The ship being already framed up, we kindly ask you to inform us - by wire - the reduction which can be expected in freeboard, provided the present scantlings remain unaltered and the tonnage well, the washports and scuppers abreast of the main deck and the scuppers in the Shelterdeck through the ship'sides are increased with.

The particulars for calculating the freeboard will be the same as for our yard No. 310.
