In connection with the Load Line assignment of this vessel, alterations have now been made to the Bridge Front which extends across to each side of the bulwarks and now being totally enclosed with 1/4" steel plates. Two watertight doors are fitted with dogs capable of being operated from each side. The forecastle openings are now closed with hinged steel doors capable of being operated from each side.

The Electrical Equipment has been completed to the Rule Requirements, except the cables leading from the Generators to the Switchboards, which will be changed to the correct sizes as soon as materials can be obtained.
