The Owners' Superintendent now states that it will not be convenient for him to complete the survey for full classification until the end of the year.

Her temporary classification and load line certificate expire at the end of July and with a view to facilitating chartering arrangements, he has now agreed to submit the vessel for another General Examination and extension of load line certificate until that time upon her arrival at Fowey about the 17th instant.

He points out that a tangible portion of the examination carried out on the vessel at Liverpool in July last was accepted by the Surveyors for full classification.

It is accordingly submitted the Falmouth Surveyors be requested to give the case attention on the lines indicated above with a view to the assignment of a fresh "Examined" date and load line certificate until the end of December next as required.

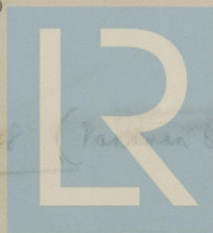
