This Tanker was built in 1945 and classed with the American Bureau of Shipping.

Classification with this Society is desired.

Plans for this type of vessel have been examined in this Office, and the scantlings and arrangements found suitable for the class 100A- "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk".

The GALVESTON Surveyor in a First Entry Report and Rpt.8, reports (9.48), the vessel examined in dry dock and afloat, the scantlings and arrangements verified, and the requirements for Vessels Not Built Under Survey. and of a Periodical Special Survey complied with.

The cutting and strapping of the deck, and shell carried out at this time.

Permanent repairs effected to shell plate No.7 in 1st strake below sheer (s.s.), and the Surveyor recommends this item be deleted from a Condition of Class.

Repairs effected to a number of fractures in bulkheads, and tee bars fitted to the bulkhead brackets in way.

"Subject to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the first opportunity"


