Vessel has now reverted to pre-war freeboard assignments.


- NOW DONE. (1) Tonnage opening in shelter deck restored and fitted with efficient temporary covers. ✓
- (2) 5" diameter overboard scupper with automatic screwdown non-return valve controlled from shelter deck fitted in tonnage well port and starboard. ✓
- (3) After tonnage bulkhead no openings. ✓
Forward tonnage bulkhead opening (p & s) fitted with 3" shifting boards in channels as originally. ✓
- (4) Scupper pipes in shelter tween decks where led to hold bilges blanked off at deck level and where led to machinery bilges lever weighted cocks fitted. ✓
- (5) Tween deck hatchways and closing appliances etc., are in order. ✓
- (6) Freeboards now marked from upper deck. ✓
