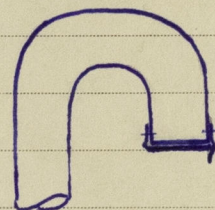
The following <sup>additional</sup> air pipes have now been fitted in connection with conversion to oil fuel burning:

On bridge deck:

Closing appliances

2 (1 port & 1 stbd.) 4 1/2" dia. 30" high to DB Tank No 2  
2 (1 port & 1 stbd.) 4 1/2" dia 30" high to O.F side bunkers.  
2 (1 port & 1 stbd.) 4" dia 6'6" high to O.F service tanks  
1 stbd side 2" dia 30" high to <sup>DB</sup> cofferdam.

hinged lids secured by springs  
thus:



Air pipes from tanks carrying oil fuel are also provided with wire gauze diaphragms at their openings.
