It is submitted a copy of the ordinary and Timber Deck cargo freeboard computations be sent to the Board of Trade and they be informed that, with reference to the assignment of timber deck cargo freeboards, the vessel has neither a poop nor raised quarter deck with hood as required by paragraph 86 of the 1932 Load Line Rules.

It is understood that the Scandinavian Authorities in similar cases either impose no penalty or impose only a very light penalty, and the Board should be requested to state what (if any) penalty they consider should be imposed in this case.

As the matter is very urgent a phone message is desired.
