The Ramsey Steamship Co.Ltd., have a new vessel building in Holland of which they will not get delivery as soon as anticipated. This means that they must keep the "BEN VEEN" and "BEN AIN" running longer, without taking them off for Special Survey.

As the "BEN VEEN" has not been drydocked since 11,60, they propose to deal with this ship first, and are arranging to stop this ship at the end of this month for Annual Drydocking, Load Line and Boiler Surveys.

If the Committee are agreeable they will then carry out a General Examination for the postponement of the Special Survey until the end of the year of grace. They hope, however, to carry out the Special Survey well within the year.

As soon as the "BEN VEEN" has been dealt with, they would like to arrange similarly for the "BEN AIN."


I have told them, that, subject to the General Examination being held in drydock, and in each case being found satisfactory, the Classification Committee will favourably consider their application.





