In reply to your letter of the 18th April, I am pleased to inform you that provided a satisfactory General Examination of the hull and machinery be made during the present drydocking at Newcastle-On-Tyne, the Committee will be prepared to consider the postponement of the Special Survey until sometime before the end of January 1964 as proposed.

The Continuous Survey of the machinery should be advanced at this time, and conclude the examination of the attached lubricating oil pump, one main air receiver and the port auxiliary dynamo engine.

I take this opportunity to remind you that the Auxiliary Boiler Survey will become due at the end of next month.
