In reply to your letter of 31st ultimo, having reference to my first entry report No.2688 on the hull of the new steamer "CARLINGFORD", I beg to state that I regret not having mentioned on the report the fact that the vessel had been taken on 4th January to Glasgow for the purpose of being fitted with her engines and boilers etc.
