CITY OF SYDNEY.—Belfast, May 24.—
A cylinder burst to-day on the new Ellerman Line steamer City of Sydney, Glasgow for Liverpool, killing an engineer and injuring three engineers. Steamer Cameronia, Glasgow for New York via Belfast, answered SOS call and the injured men were transferred to her and landed at Belfast on Saturday evening (May 24).—
