Letters were recently received from the Standard Steam Fishing Co.Ltd., and its associated companies, the Loyal Steam Fishing Co. Ltd., and the Great Grimsby & East Coast Steam Fishing Co.Ltd., signifying their intention to withdraw their Fleets of Trawlers from classification.

Thirty two trawlers were involved, the average age of which was about eighteen years, and despite representations made, the Owners, for reasons of economy, still adhere to their decision and have requested that the classification of the Fleets should be withdrawn as soon as the vessels become due for survey.

Under this arrangement, twelve trawlers have now to be dealt with, a special periodical survey being due in each case.

The matter was before the Classification Committee on Friday, the 7th instant, when, in the circumstances, they decided to give instructions for the vessels' characters to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
