 examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the  
 (Name of Vessel) *M.S. "Harpagus" Lying at Messrs Swan Hunter & Wigham Richardson  
 Dry docks*  
 on the (Date of examination) *May 20<sup>th</sup>* 1946.

I have to report that I found *The main mast and iron work of same*  
*in good condition but recommend new seizing on main mast shroud*  
*size in number, otherwise all shrouds in good condition, six cargo*  
*derricks in good condition, but recommend rigging screws be fixed*  
*two derrick posts and iron work in good condition, strops of*  
*same in good condition but recommend all rigging screws be fixed*  
*and made workable.*

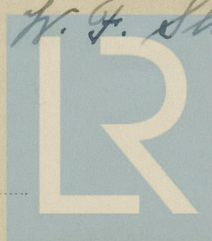
