Having, in accordance with your instructions, examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the
(Name of Vessel) *M.S. "Harpagus" Lying at Messrs Swan Hunter & Wigham Richardson Dry docks*
on the (Date of examination) *May 20th* 1946.

I have to report that I found *The main mast and iron work of same in good condition but recommend new seizing on main mast shroud side in number, otherwise all shrouds in good condition, six cargo derricks in good condition, but recommend rigging screws be fixed two derrick posts and iron work in good condition, strops of same in good condition but recommend all rigging screws be fixed and made workable.*
