THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Undersigned Surveyors to this Society, did, at the request of the Admiralty, survey during construction, the Hull and Electrical equipment of the Fore end of the steel screw motor vessel "TREWORLAS" (ex "HARPAGUS") 7265 tons gross, of London, built by Messrs. Shipbuilding Corporation Ltd., (Tyne Branch), Walker Shipyard, Newcastle-on-Tyne.

The New Fore End has been built and equipped in accordance with the requirements of the Society for Class 100A1.

All the requirements of the finally approved plans and Admiralty "As fitted" specification have been carried out.

The trial of the windlass was carried out on the River Tyne on the 30th August, 1946, with satisfactory results.
