With reference to my letter of the 2nd instant, regarding the order placed with the Shipbuilding Corporation Ltd. (Tyne Branch) for a new fore end for the above ship (A/MS 1613), I am now informed by the Director of Navy Contracts (Merchant Shipbuilding Division) that an order has been placed with Messrs. Swan, Hunter, & Wigham Richardson Ltd., Wallsend-on-Tyne, for the following work:-

- (a) the repair of the existing after end;
- (b) engine overhaul;
- (c) the subsequent joining together of new fore-end with existing after end to rehabilitate the above-mentioned vessel to her condition before the casualty.

The supervision of the work will be carried out by the Admiralty Merchant Ship Repair Principal Licensing Officer, North East England, together with representatives of this Society, to both of whose requirements the whole of the work is to be carried out.

You will not be required to certify progress of work for instalment payments.
