Fore End for S.S. "HARPAGUS", A/MS 1613.

I am advised by the Director of Navy Contracts (MS) that an order has been placed, under the Emergency Merchant Shipbuilding Programme, with the Shipbuilding Corporation Ltd. (Tyne Branch) for the construction of a new fore end for the above ship. The Firm has been instructed that the supervision of the construction will be within the scope of the Admiralty Merchant Repair Principal Licensing Officer, North East England, together with the Society's representatives; you will be responsible also for the certification of progress of work for instalment payments in accordance with the following scheme:-

- One-quarter when sufficient material delivered in the yard for proceeding with the work.
- One-quarter when the fore end is framed or equivalent amount of work done.
- One-quarter when the fore end is plated or equivalent amount of work done.
- One-quarter when the fore end is launched and ready for transport.
