*Surveyed the S/S "TOMOGERUS" 10671 tons gross of London whilst afloat and on dry dock at Todd Shipyards Corporation, Galveston, Texas on the 10th to the 23rd April, 1948 for Docking, full Special Survey for Classification in the Society's Register Book, Hull Repairs, and fitting of riveted crack arresters on the decks, sides, and bottom of vessel,*

*and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and*

*that I have **Recommended** that she be classed in the Society's Register Book, viz. 100A1 with notation now of Docking Date 4,48 and S.S. Gal. 4,48, subject to shaft tunnel W.T. door to operate from Freeboard Deck, also 30 fathoms of cable to supply first opportunity,*

*being fit to carry petroleum in bulk.*
