Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Genoa have forwarded to this Office a copy of your letter of the 29th October last, addressed to them, from which I regret to learn that, for reasons of economy, you have decided not to continue the classification of your steamer "TAIGETE" in this Society's Register Book.

The case has been submitted to the Committee at their meeting today, and I am directed to say that, in the circumstances, instructions have been given for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (,...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
