I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 9th inst re first entry report 55833 on S/S El Lobo and in reply thereto I beg to state that the thicknesses of C. D & E strakes of shell plating are correctly given in the report, and are as required by the approved plans.

With regard to the equipment, four 90 lbs 7" manda howzers were supplied and I much regret that I failed to state this in the report.

There are 15 water-tight bulkheads complete to the height of the main deck and 9 of these are carried complete to the height of the upper deck.
