that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all repairs effected by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and have Recommended that she be retained as now entered in the Register Book without fresh record of damage subject to the ship being towed direct to Istanbul for docking and permanent repairs.
