

VERY URGENT

Motorship "ERNEBANK"

Captain Gale, representing the Owners, called at this office this afternoon and said that this ship is proceeding to Hamburg and will complete discharge by Monday. The Owners now require her to load a cargo of fertiliser from Hamburg to a Far East port and thence in ballast to a breaking-up port in the Far East. For this purpose they will require an interim certificate as a classed ship together with Load Line certificates, and they desire to know by letter on Monday morning our minimum requirements for this voyage.

Wait for 3/4 months

They have been warned that the Committee may require a modified Special Survey, but have raised the question as to whether it will be necessary to drydock before undertaking the voyage.

Submitted ship be opened up as for special Survey, including dry docking, and found or placed in a satisfactory condition for a modified S.S. notation to cover length of time of postponement desired.
