**THETA STAR.** — Singapore, Feb. 25. — Following received from Singapore Radio: Following received on 500 kcs. SOS from ZCKV, steamer Theta Star aground Etna Droogte at 1 38 a.m. local time, position lat. 5 17 5 S., long. 106 54 E. require assistance, all lights not functioning on ship, now moderate light wind.

— Singapore, Feb. 25. — Following received from Singapore Radio: Following received on 500 kcs. from PKI (Djakarta Radio):

At 8 22 p.m., G.M.T.: ICDS (motor vessel Neptunia) ready to sail to Etna Droogte at 5 a.m., local time.

At 8 28 p.m., G.M.T., addressed ZCKV (steamer Theta Star): Following received from harbour-master pilot: Tug perhaps in morning hour ready to your assistance.

Following received on 500 kcs. at 10 46 p.m., G.M.T.: SOS from ZCKV. Theta Star, aground Etna Droogte, require immediate assistance, sea moderate but increasing, wind NW. by N. force 5 (fresh breeze), visibility good.

— Singapore, Feb. 26. — Following received from Singapore Radio: Following received via Djakarta Radio from steamer Theta Star: Cleared reef and afloat at 1 50 a.m., G.M.T., Feb. 26, heading Djakarta, QUM (distress traffic ended) at 1 50 a.m., G.M.T., Feb. 26.
