The 1st Special Survey No.2 of this vessel became due in November, 1930, and to complete the Boiler Survey, due 4,31, the Donkey Boiler Survey requires to be held.

On the 2nd October last the Classing Committee agreed to a proposal by the Owners to postpone the Special Survey and completion of Boiler survey until/the end of the year of grace (December, 1931), on the understanding that the surveys would be completed, without fail, by that time.

The Oslo Surveyor now forwards a letter, dated 8th instant, received by him from the Owners in which it is stated that they have decided to transfer the vessel's class to the Norske Veritas.

The Classing Committee had the case before them Tuesday, 22nd instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu of the withdrawal of class at Owners request.
