

ship for a contemplated voyage in tow as a hulk to Hong
Kong or a Japanese Port.

The weather decks, closing appliances and
machinery spaces were examined also boiler under steam,
generator ballast and bilge pumps under working conditions.
Selected bilges were tested and the sounding book examined
over the period since the ship arrived in Bombay and no
significant changes noted.

The ship was on 9th May 1963 in my opinion in
fit state to be towed as a hulk to Hong Kong or a
Japanese Port.
