Dear Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th. ultimo, enclosing Classification Certificates on the S. S. "CANADIAN SKIRMISHER", recently built by the Wallace Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Company.

I note that the amounts \$45.00, and \$30.00 should have been charged for First Entry Fee on hull and machinery in accordance with the revised rules, and regret that this was overlooked when forwarding our account to the Builders.

In reply to your enquiry as to whether a fee in accordance with Circular No. 1351 has been charged for the survey of electric lighting installation of this vessel, I may state that this fee was not charged, and in view of the fact, that our fee to the Builders for survey of hull and machinery has been increased considerably, to the fee recently charged for the survey of the Sister Ship "CANADIAN HIGHLANDER", I beg to recommend that in this case the charge for survey of electric lighting installation may be dispensed with, and unless receiving further instructions from you an account will not be issued from this office.


I may say that the Builder's check in payment of our account for survey while building has not yet been paid, and the Certificates are being held until a check for the amount of our account, already rendered is received.
