Nature of Survey \_\_\_\_\_

The class is subject to six lengths of chain cable being supplied ~~before the end of February 1936~~ to replace worn cable and to indented plating being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The Barcelona Surveyor now reports the chain cable, as above, placed in order, the six lengths required having now been placed on board.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey subject as above except as regards chain cable.
