S. I beg to refer you to my letters of the 11th March last and 6th ultimo respecting the Boiler Survey and Special Survey No.3 which became due, respectively, at the end of January and June last on the Steamer "NIKOLAI EJOE".

In the absence of any reply from you to these communications, it is concluded that it is not your wish to have the above inspections carried out with a view to the retention of this vessel's class, and I am directed to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee, who have today had the case before them have given instructions for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book, and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
