Further to our letter of the 3rd instant we beg to inform you that we are now in receipt of a letter from Messrs. Halcyon Lijn N.V., stating that the vessel's sailing schedule has been altered.

When the ship will have discharged at this Port at the end of December, she will proceed in ballast to Hampton Roads, where a cargo of coal will be loaded for Rotterdam. The ship is expected to arrive at Rotterdam about the middle of February.

At that time the Owners will take a definite decision whether the Special Survey will be held or a general examination in drydock with a view to postpone the Special Survey.

We trust that this proposal will meet with the Committee's approval and we shall be glad to have your reply for the information of the Owners and of the Netherlands Shipping Inspectorate, who are awaiting the Committee's decision.
