This T-2 tanker was built 1944 by the Kaiser Company Incorporated, and classed with the American Bureau of Shipping.

Classification with this Society is now desired.

The FAIRMOUTH Surveyors report this tanker placed in dry dock, a GENERAL EXAMINATION held, and minor repairs effected.

Anchors and cables were ranged at this time but not verified with certificates.

The vessel has now on board 3 bower anchors, 1 stream anchor, and 270 fathoms of chain cable, which is 60 fathoms below Rule requirements. It is recommended 60 fathoms of cable be placed on board at the first opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to have the temporary class 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in bulk" (Classification Contemplated), with record of docking survey 10.47, subject to 60 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the first opportunity; and to have notation of "Examined 10.47", valid for 12 months, assigned as recommended.
