With reference to our recent telephone conversation regarding the service limits of this ship, I have to acquaint you that the case has now been investigated and there will be no objection to the ship trading between Las Palmas and Rio de Oro.

Provided, therefore, the outstanding Classification and Load Line Surveys are held and the ship is found satisfactory, the Committee will be agreeable to the present Classification geographical service limits being amended to read - "For service U.K. and Eire (excluding the West Coast of Ireland), also to and from the Baltic and Mediterranean and to Rio de Oro and Las Palmas".

Load Line Certificates to cover this amended service will be issued which will enable the ship to reach the contemplated service station and to trade as proposed.

Perhaps you will be so good as to let me know when definite arrangements have been made to submit the ship to inspection and confirm that the new service limits are required.
