STORM AT VALPARAISO
Santiago, Chile, June 27. — Due to severe storm at Valparaiso last night, steamer ALGARROBO, with a full cargo of coal, reported sinking after striking coal mole. Owners believe salvage impossible.

2229/6/63

ALGARROBO. — Valparaiso, June 27. — Steamer Algarrobo, loaded with coal, due to heavy storm on June 27 stranded on rocks alongside Valparaiso Baron Mole; touching rocks, submerged to main deck, rudder broken, propeller lost, port 50 deg. (list). Impossible to board due to rocks and seas breaking over wreck. Consider constructive total loss. — Lloyd's Sub-agents per Salvage Association. (See issue of June 28.)
