I am obliged to you for your memorandum of the 10th instant and have now brought this case before the Committee.

They have commented on the fact that the tug was built so long ago as 1912 and has not been seen in dry dock since December 1956, which is two years ago, the maximum period contemplated by the Rules.

The Committee are of course appreciative of all the difficulties with which the Owners have been faced in the strike which has affected their fleet, but consider in view of the position mentioned above that the Owners should give a firm proposal as to the date by which this vessel can be seen in dry dock if she is to maintain her class.

I shall therefore be obliged if you will again take this matter up with the Owners and let me have their further comments.
